ustainable CT is a free, voluntary certification program that supports and recognizes thriving and resilient Connecticut municipalities. An independently funded, grassroots effort, Sustainable CT provides a wide-ranging menu of best practices. Municipalities choose Sustainable CT actions, implement them, and earn points toward certification.

Sustainable CT also provides opportunities for grant funding through its Community Match Fund program to help communities promote economic well-being and enhance equity, all while respecting the finite capacity of the natural environment. The program is designed to support all Connecticut municipalities, regardless of size, geography, or resources.

Sustainable CT is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization and a <u>1% for the Planet Environmental Partner</u>.

About the Goodspeed



he Goodspeed opened its doors as a professional musical theatre in 1963 in an historic building on the banks of the Connecticut River in the center of East Haddam. This exceptional venue has hosted over 250 musicals, including over 70 world premieres, and has exported 21 productions to Broadway.

The Victorian-style building was constructed in 1876 -1877 by merchant and banker William Goodspeed as a theatre, general store, and steamboat port. It includes a grand staircase, brass-rail bar, and balcony overlooking the river. The theatre seats 398 (297 at orchestra level). A park and dock are adjacent to the property, and free, accessible parking is in close proximity. The fully restored building is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

EAST HADDAM is known for its scenic beauty, historic sites, and vibrant arts community. The town achieved Silver certification and Climate Leader designation in the Sustainable CT program in the fall of 2024.


