


## Trumbull achieved Bronze Certification on September 27, 2023 with 310 points.

Trumbull registered with Sustainable CT in 2018. Since registering, the town has held three certifications: Bronze in 2020; Silver in 2021; and Bronze once again in 2023 with 310 points.
