






Fairfield achieved Gold certification with 845 points, and Climate Leader Designation with 230 points in the fall of 2024.



Watershed protection and restoration: a Fairfield success story

Fairfield is addressing watershed protection and restoration through a collaborative effort with Bridgeport.

Together, the towns replanted 42,000 plugs of beach grass at the Ash Creek sand spit to stabilize the area and reduce erosion. This initiative will help protect the surrounding tidal wetlands and nearby homes, demonstrating a strong commitment to preserving the local environment.
