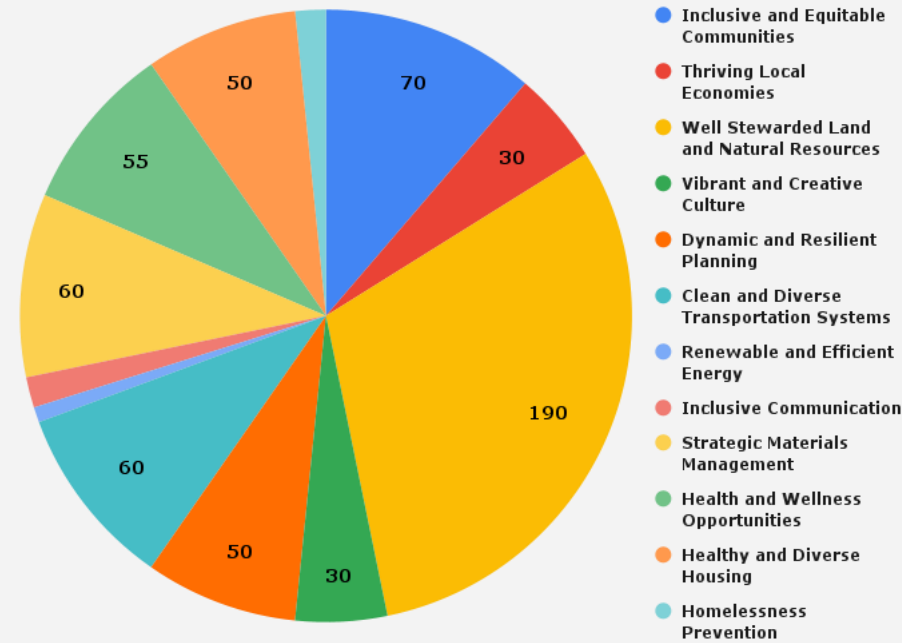


**BRONZE AND SILVER
CERTIFICATION**

Marlborough achieved Bronze certification with 270 points in the spring of 2024, and Silver certification with 620 points in the fall of 2024.
