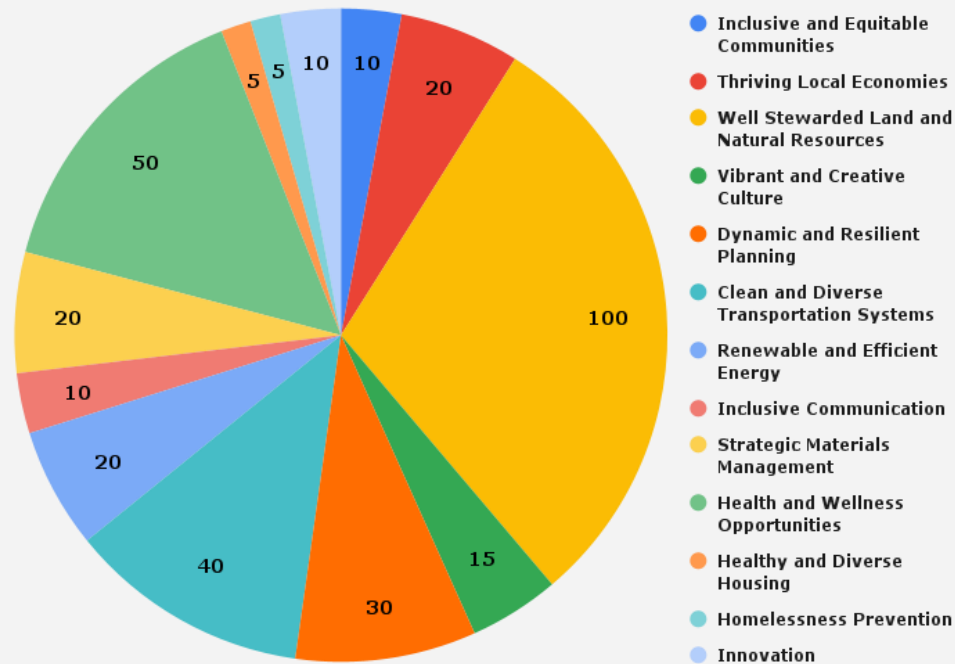




**Monroe achieved Bronze certification with 335 point in the fall of 2024.**

**Promoting the C-PACE program: a Monroe success story**

Monroe demonstrates its commitment to sustainable development by supporting property owners—including commercial, industrial, non-profit, and multifamily—in accessing affordable financing for energy-efficient upgrades. Through the C-PACE (Commercial Property Assessed Clean Energy) program, the town empowers building owners to invest in improvements like solar panels, efficient HVAC systems, and energy-saving lighting.
