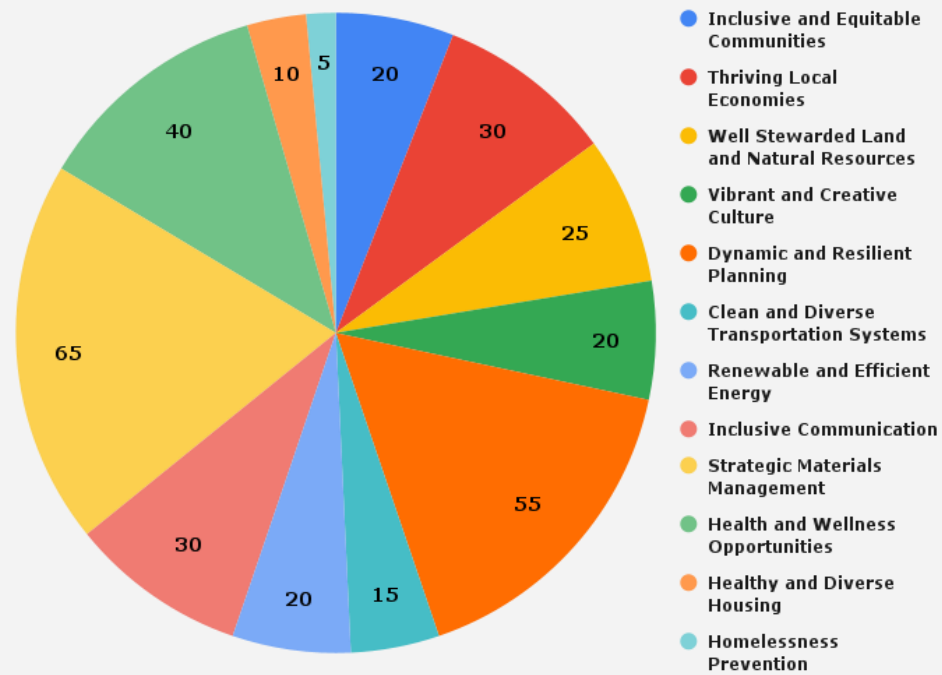




**Suffield achieved Bronze certification with 335 points in the fall of 2024.**
