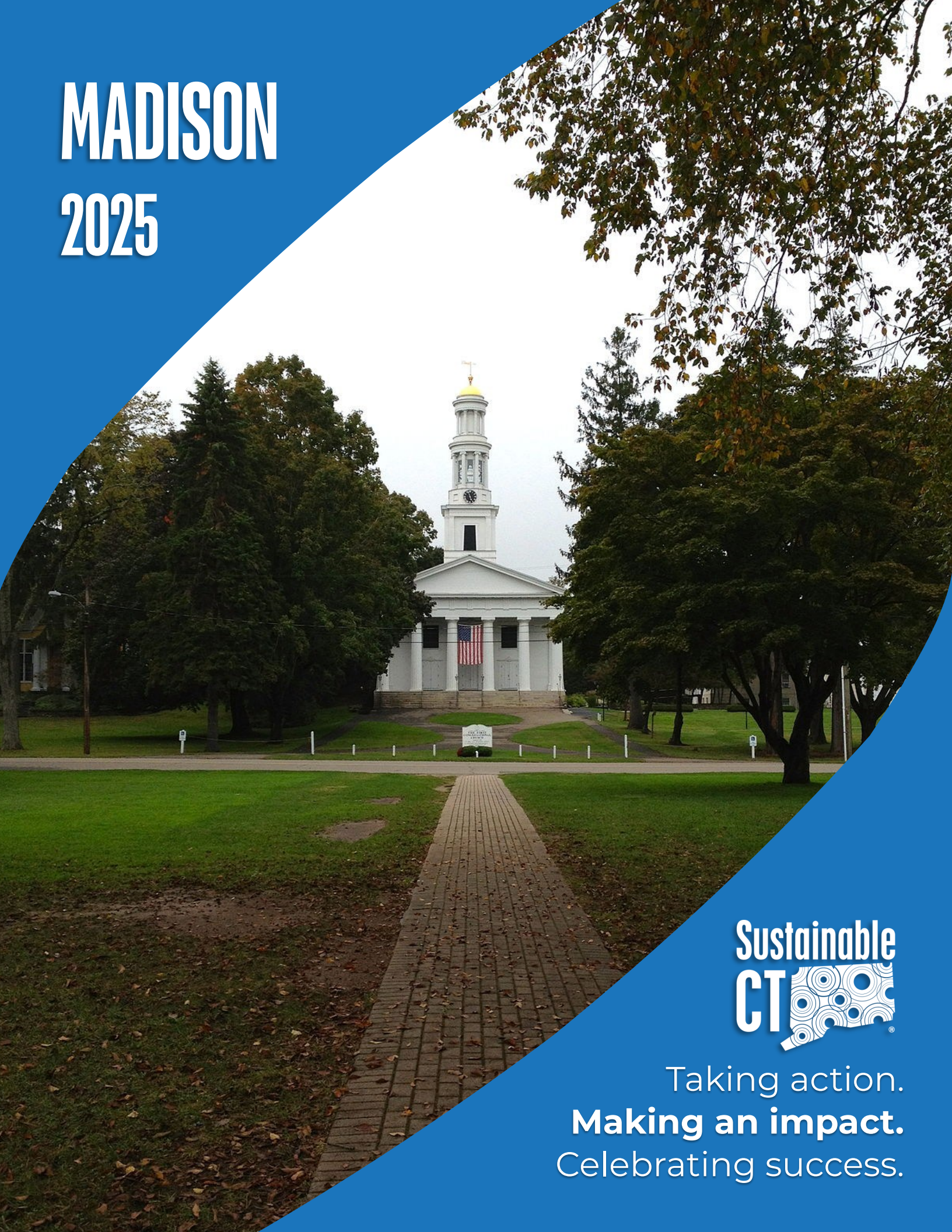


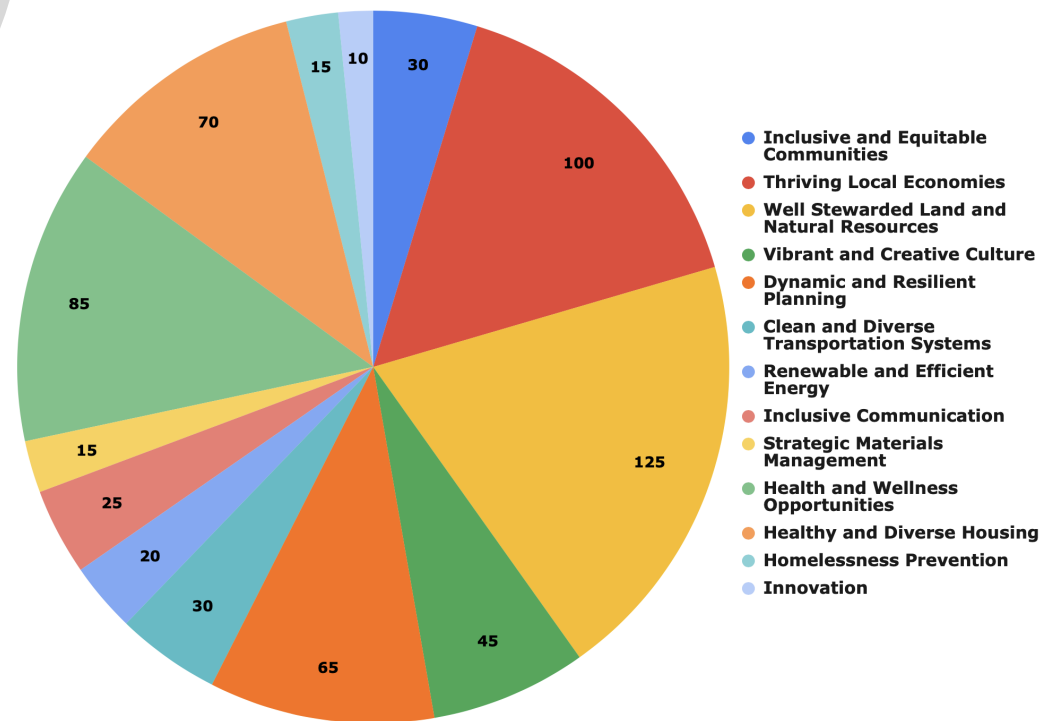

Madison collaborates to reduce waste

The Guilford and Madison Transfer Station is a solid waste disposal site maintained by the two towns. In March 2023, Guilford and Madison began a pilot composting program with curbside pickup in both towns. Through this collaboration, Madison has helped address Connecticut's waste crisis by facilitating waste diversion practices. Madison has set an example for other municipalities by demonstrating the effectiveness of multi-municipality composting programs.

Improving outdoor access: a Madison success story

Madison is committed to improving access to the outdoors. For example, in 2023 the town completed the Salt Meadow Dog Park, creating a space for residents and pets alike to enjoy the outdoors together. Additionally, the town installed a new playground at the Surf Club with interactive elements and mats, creating a more accessible space. Madison is taking steps to create outdoor spaces that can be enjoyed by the entire community.



Madison achieved Silver Certification on October 1, 2025 with 635 points.

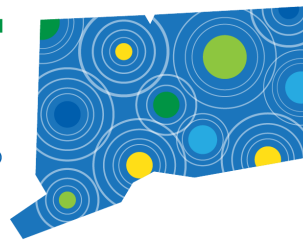
